Topics covered..... **CHEMMAT 740** Advanced Polymer Materials. To understand the structure, properties, and processing inter-relationships of materials used in the plastics industry and how these impinge on material selection and processing.

CHEMMAT 741 Processing of Plastics. To understand how materials used in plastics behave under processing conditions. This includes the effects of additives on processing and degradation of plastics and the major mixing and forming techniques.
